### 3. New Business

# Jeremiah Blankenbaker presented the status of active Capital Projects

- 080054 Joshua Place Water Infiltration
  - o Jeremiah Blankenbaker reported that work was restarted and completed for all items but the installation of the benches in front of Bld 6 and 8. The benches are on order and will be installed as soon as possible
- 080059 Roll-in Shower Unit A & B Crawford
  - O Work is expected to start on May 15th
  - CO1- 2 Symmons Visu Temp shower fixtures
    - DDS requires that all programs supported by them have temperature regulators on the program's plumbing fixtures. This was not known during the design phase of the project.
    - The total cost of the upgrade is \$687, to install the required regulators in both bathrooms.
    - Jeremiah Blankenbaker requested Board approval for Charge Order #1 to install Symmons Visu Temp regulators
    - Motion to approve Change order #1 for Project #080059. Donald Cristina motioned 2 to approve Change order #1 for Project #080059. The motion was seconded by, which upon being put to a vote was passed unanimously
- 080057 Flooring Replacement Crawford
  - o The contract and the NTP has been issued with work expected to start on May 14th
- 080060 Water Damage in Building 15 Units 1B & 3B
  - OGCE Architecture has presented the Authority with the lowest qualified bidder for the Water Damage in Building 15 Units 1B & 3B project.
  - o Zander Corp has submitted a bid of \$44,000. Their references have provided positive feedback from their past work and are the recommended contractors for this project.
  - Jeremiah Blankenbaker requested that the Board provide approval to accept Zander Corp's bid and move forward on the project.
    - Motion to approve Zander Corp's bid Project #080060. Donald Cristina motioned<sup>3</sup> to approve Zander Corp's bid Project #080060. The motion was seconded by Thomas Placzek, which upon being put to a vote was passed unanimously
- ADA Compliance Upgrades to the Community Building Entry Ways
  - o RFQs have been drafted and sent to several contractors, with quotes due to the Authority by May 31st
